Each of the theme answers (the longest across entries) included a "triple double" of letters - specifically SS, LL, and OO, in that order. Our answer was an NBA player (which made sense since a "triple double" is a [combination of statistics in basketball](#)), so a good idea was to search to see if any well-known players matched the SS-LL-OO combination. And indeed, there is one guy who fits our pattern: **RUSSELL WESTBROOK**, who is our meta answer. Amazingly, Russell Westbrook also holds the NBA record for most triple-doubles (the statistical type, not the alphabetic type), so he's an especially good fit for the meta, and the "record-holding" part of the prompt last week hopefully helped you realize that!
