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a 6-letter word

Last week's puzzle did not have any obvious theme answers if you just looked at the lengths of all the entries, but there were six words that appeared to not match their clues at all. For each of those six odd clue/entry pairings, there was an additional entry in the grid that was a mutual synonym of the clue and the entry. Putting those mutual synonyms in between the clue and the entry would connect the two, and ultimately make a lot more sense. Taking the first letters of those In-between words (in order of the original entries) spelled out **LIAISE**, a synonym for the title "Go Between" and our met answer.
